While disgruntled employee situations are uncomfortable they are also an unfortunate reality that business owners must be prepared for. In one recent case, a client company faced a serious security concern after a former employee left under difficult circumstances and was later involved in a federal investigation. However, since they’d brought iTech to the table they secured the organization. Since the organization had implemented modern access control systems, administrators

were able to immediately restrict building access without having to replace every lock in the facility, in a timely fashion, which is important in these types of unfortunate scenarios. “Years ago, you would have had to physically change every lock and key in the building,” Williams explained. “Today, you can simply deactivate access and protect the facility instantly.”

Cybersecurity threats have also become a growing concern for organizations of every size. Ransomware attacks, phishing attempts, and financial fraud schemes targeting ACH payments have forced many companies to rethink how they safeguard their systems. “Business owners work incredibly hard to build their companies,” Williams said. “They spend years filling the bucket – growing revenue, investing in people, building something meaningful. If one of the leaks in that bucket is theft, ransomware, or fraud, it can undo an enormous amount of work.”

Williams emphasized that protecting businesses from these threats is a driving motivation behind the company’s continued expansion.

“We know what it means to pour time, energy, and resources into building a successful business that contributes positively to clients, employees and the community at large,” he said. “Our mission is to help other business owners protect what they’ve worked so hard to create. When companies are secure, they can focus on serving their customers, supporting their employees, and contributing positively to the community.”

With the opening of its new Marietta location, iTech plans

to continue expanding its portfolio of security, IT, and technology services while maintaining the personalized, community-driven approach that has defined the company for years.

“Our success is tied directly to the success of the businesses around us,” Williams concluded. “By staying close to our clients and investing in the communities we serve, we can continue delivering the kind of service that helps local companies thrive.”
